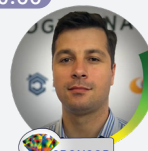

ENERG+ - Developed by OAER for all designers, engineers, architects and energy auditors for buildings in Romania

The ENERG+ software was designed to be used by all energy auditors for buildings but also by architects and designers in the field of building services and construction. ENERG+ is intended both for the energy certification of multi-zonal buildings or building units, as well as for apartments. The program can also be used as an energy design tool for nZEB buildings, new or renovated buildings, including in the "lifetime" license version the economic calculations from audit reports.

Created in a complex programming language, ENERG+ has an interactive interface, offering the energy auditor a very useful and fast tool for energy certification and auditing.



DOSET-PEC - Calculation Software for Energy Performance of Buildings and Apartments

The company Dosetimpex SRL, Timișoara - IT department, developed this computer program, "Doset-PEC", in order to ease the tasks of certified energy auditors for the preparation of the energy audit and the development of the energy certificate of a building/apartment.

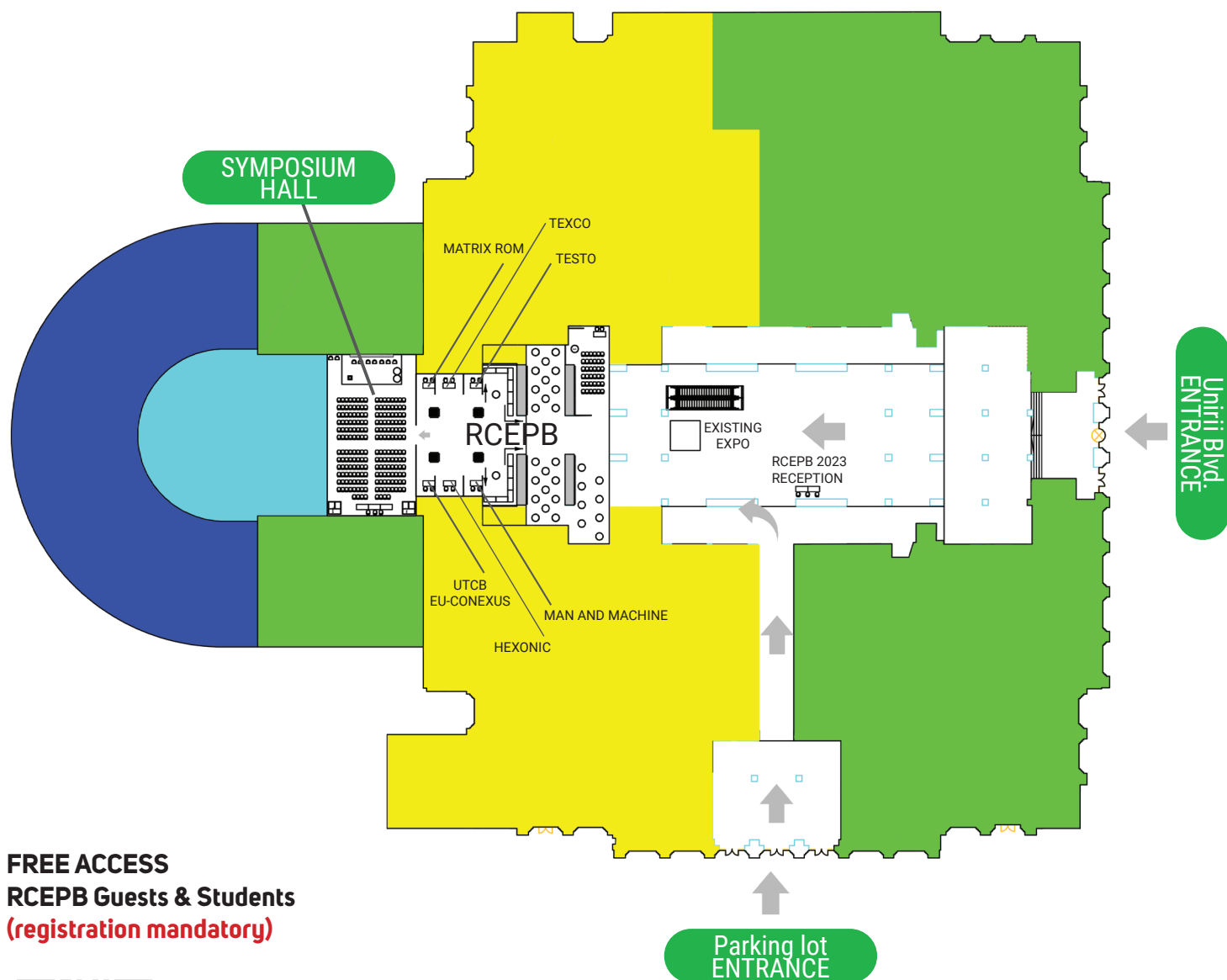
The program interface is friendly, easy, with an attractive design and well organized, so that the user can access the main functions of the program with a simple click. Having all the available information about the building to be certified, it takes 25-30 minutes to enter the data and issue the energy certificate.

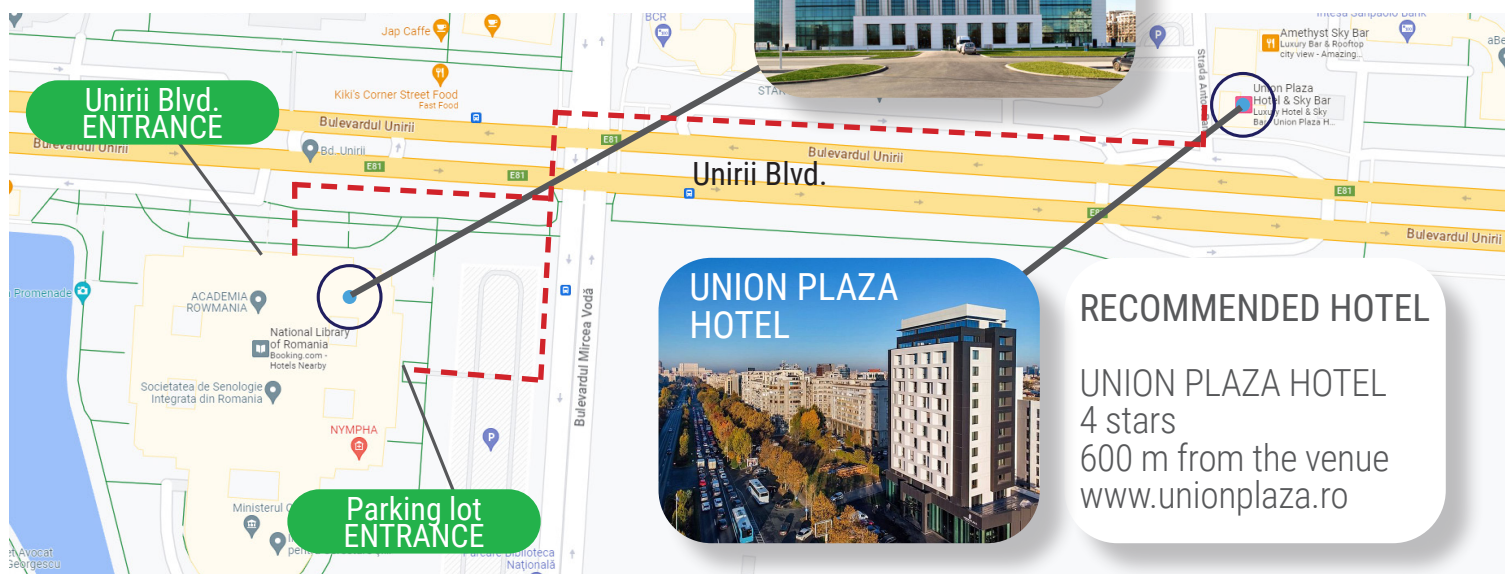
